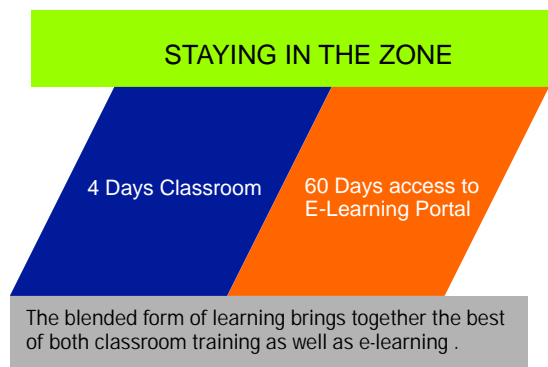

BLENDED LEARNING

Eligibility & Application Support

Oversight & content support

Multiple learning tools
